Lone Star Credit Union bylaws provide for the election of the Board of Directors. The Nominating Committee has selected one candidate for each open position. The selected candidates are Ryan Holloway and Dr. Graham Sweeney.

Board of Directors Required Qualifications & Duties

To serve on LSCU's Board of Directors, you must be willing to (1) be a Member in good standing of LSCU, (2) serve as a volunteer without pay for a three-year term, (3) become informed on credit union history, bylaws, policies, procedures, budgets, strategies, financial statements, etc., (4) attend regular monthly meetings, occasional special meetings, and training events, (5) act as an ambassador for the credit union.
